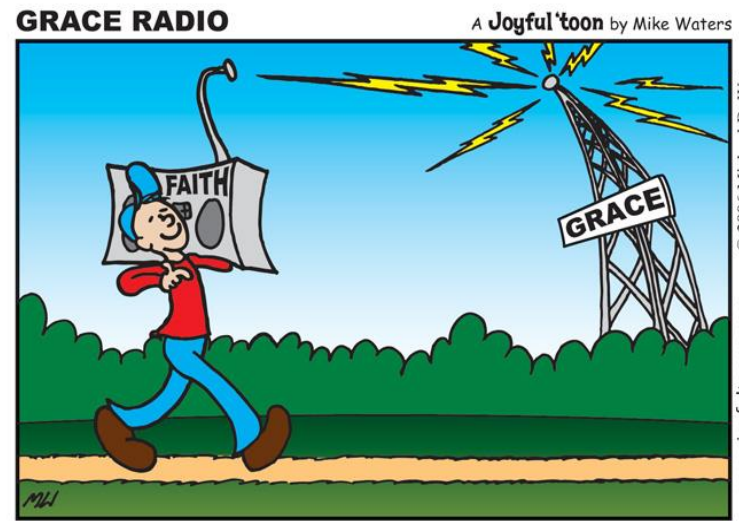

Today's Devotional:

Throughout his ministry, we see Jesus heal the sick, give sight to the blind, drive out demons and even bring the dead back to life. These miracles made an impression on the witnesses. But note here how he takes his power up a notch. He does not just perform a physical miracle, he promises spiritual wellness.

“When Jesus saw their faith, he said, ‘Friend, your sins are forgiven.’ The Pharisees and the teachers of the law began thinking to themselves, ‘Who is this fellow who speaks blasphemy? Who can forgive sins but God alone?’ Jesus knew what they were thinking and asked, ‘Why are you thinking these things in your hearts? Which is easier: to say, ‘Your sins are forgiven,’ or to say, ‘Get up and walk’? But that you may know

that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins....’ He said to the paralyzed man, ‘I tell you, get up, take your mat and go home.’ Immediately he stood up in front of them, took what he had been lying on and went home praising God. Everyone was amazed and gave praise to God. They were filled with awe and said, ‘We have seen remarkable things today.’” Luke 5:20-26

We weren't seeing some faith healer. This wasn't a series of ruses. Jesus had not only the power to heal, he did indeed have the power to forgive. The Pharisees were right on one thing: only God has the power to forgive sins — and that is exactly the point. Jesus was God in the flesh. He left his home in heaven to come to earth and live as a man. He taught, he healed, he forgave and he eventually sacrificed himself on the cross to pay our sin debt. Let us be humbled and thankful.
