Today's Devotional

A very important concept is shown here. The Israelites were to make regular offerings for different purposes. What they offered was to be without blemish; it was to be their best...

"The Lord called Moses and spoke to him from the tent of meeting, saying, "Speak to the people of Israel and say to them, When any one of you brings an offering to the Lord, you shall bring your offering of livestock from the herd or from the flock. "If his offering is a burnt offering from the herd, he shall offer a male without blemish. He shall bring it to the entrance of the tent of meeting, that he may be accepted before the Lord." Leviticus 1:1-3 ESV

Note the references here to leaven (yeast) and salt...

"No grain offering that you bring to the Lord shall be made with leaven, for you shall burn no leaven nor any honey as a food offering to the Lord. You shall season all your grain offerings with salt. You shall not let the salt of the covenant with your God be missing from your grain offering; with all your offerings you shall offer salt." Leviticus 2:11, 13 ESV

In the New Testament, Jesus plays off these terms. We are told to beware of false teaching (referred to as the leaven of the Pharisees) and to be the salt of the world.

As Christians, we are under a different covenant. Jesus was and is our perfect sacrifice, a lamb without blemish. In response, we are to give ... our money, our time, our service. Are we giving our best? Or does God get our leftovers?

Today's Devotional

We find three foundational principles laid out in Leviticus.

"And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to all the congregation of the people of Israel and say to them, You shall be holy, for I the Lord your God am holy. Every one of you shall revere his mother and his father, and you shall keep my Sabbaths: I am the Lord your God. Do not turn to idols or make for yourselves any gods of cast metal: I am the Lord your God." Leviticus 19:1-4 ESV

Old covenant, new covenant - we are commanded to put God first. Idolatry is us trying to create our own God on our own terms. It has been a flaw across humanity from the beginning and is prevalent today. Let us be diligent in this matter.

At the end of our worship assembly today, Samantha Stewart will give a short presentation about this year's camping season at Tidal River Christian Camp.

Today's Devotional

This is an important parable; one that foreshadowed what was soon to happen.

"...“A man planted a vineyard and put a fence around it and dug a pit for the winepress and built a tower, and leased it to tenants and went into another country. When the season came, he sent a servant to the tenants to get from them some of the fruit of the vineyard. And they took him and beat him and sent him away empty-handed. Again he sent to them another servant, and they struck him on the head and treated him shamefully. And he sent another, and him they killed. And so with many others: some they beat, and some they killed. He had still one other, a beloved son. Finally he sent him to them, saying, ‘They will respect my son.’ But those tenants said to one another, ‘This is the heir. Come, let us kill him, and the inheritance will be ours.’ And they took him and killed him and threw him out of the vineyard. What will the owner of the vineyard do? He will come and destroy the tenants and give the vineyard to others. Have you not read this Scripture:

“‘The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; this was the Lord’s doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes.’”
Mark 12:1-11 ESV

The religious leaders of that day did indeed reject the cornerstone, the very Son of God. Jesus fulfilled dozens of messianic prophecies yet their hearts were too stubborn to accept Him. They would soon have him killed, thinking it would end the movement he was initiating. But the words, actions and sacrifice of Jesus carries on to today. And they will remain relevant until He comes again. Today, far too many are similarly hard hearted toward God and the need for a Savior. Let us do what we can to explain that need.

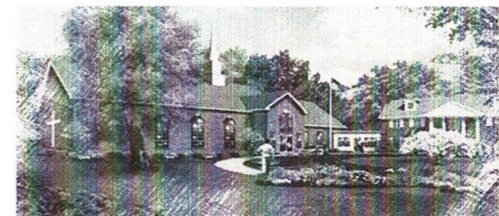
